

Quarry Dynamics Inc. Privacy and Cookie Policy

Effective 06/15/2022

This Privacy Policy explains how Quarry Dynamics Inc., along with its subsidiaries, (collectively “QD”) , collects, uses and discloses information about you when you use our website, security token dashboard, and other services (collectively, the “Services”), when you interact with us as described below.

We may change this Privacy Policy from time to time at our sole discretion. If we make changes, we will notify you by revising the date at the top of this Privacy Policy, and the updated Privacy Policy will be posted via a hyperlink at the bottom of our website homepage. In some cases, we may provide you with additional notice (such as by adding a statement relating to Privacy Policy changes to our website homepage or by sending an email notification). We encourage you to review this Privacy Policy whenever you access the Services to stay informed about our information practices and the choices available to you.

It is your obligation to periodically visit our Website to review any changes that may be made to this Privacy Policy. Your continued use of our Website and Services constitutes your agreement to be bound by our Privacy Policy and any changes to the Privacy Policy. If you do not agree with this Privacy Policy, you are not authorized to use our Website and your sole recourse is to not use our Website or the Services.

We understand that your privacy is important, and we are strongly committed to protecting it. This includes the Personal Data or Information that you may provide when you access and use content we own or operate or access via quarrydynamics.com, or any other websites, app, pages, features, or content we own or operate (hereafter: the “Site(s)”) and/or when you use our mobile application and related services (referred to collectively hereinafter as “Services”).

In addition, information that you submit to QD in response to an email, request for information or other outreach to QD, or through any QD application processes, will also be treated in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

QD is committed to maintaining the accuracy, confidentiality, and security of your personally identifiable information (“Personal Information”). As part of this commitment, the QD privacy policy governs QD’s actions as they relate to the collection, use and disclosure of Personal Information. The QD privacy policy for:

A. all users *other than those located* in the *EU*, is based upon the regulations set by the Canadian Standards Association’s Model Code for the Protection of Personal Information and Canada’s *Personal Information Protection and Electronic Documents Act (PIPEDA)*, and

B. all users located in the *EU*, is based upon the regulations set by *GDPR*.

Introduction

We are responsible for maintaining and protecting the Personal Information under QD’s control. We have designated an individual or individuals who is/are responsible for compliance with the QD privacy policy.

1. Acceptance of QD Privacy Policy

By exploring and using QD’s Site and/or Services, and by submitting information to QD, you signify acceptance to the terms of our Privacy Policy.

QD may provide additional “just-in-time” disclosures or additional information about the data collection, use and sharing practices of specific Services.

If you do not agree with any aspect of this Privacy Policy, you should immediately discontinue access or use of our Services.

2. Identifying Purposes

We collect, use and disclose Personal Information to provide you with the product or service you have requested and to offer you additional products and services we believe you might be interested in. The purposes for which we collect Personal Information will be identified before or at the time we collect the information. In certain circumstances, the purposes for which information is collected may be clear, and consent may be implied, such as where your name, address and payment information are provided as part of the order process.

3. Consent

Knowledge and consent are required for the collection, use or disclosure of Personal Information except where required or permitted by law. Providing us with your Personal Information is always your choice. However, your decision not to provide certain information may limit ability to provide you with the QD products or services. We will not require you to consent to the collection, use, or disclosure of information as a condition to the supply of a product or service, except as required to be able to supply the product or service.

4. Limiting Collection

Personal Data is data that can be used to identify you directly or indirectly, or to contact you. Our Privacy Policy covers all Personal Data that you voluntarily submit to us and that we obtain from our partners. This Privacy Policy does not apply to anonymized data, as it cannot be used to identify you. You may be asked to provide Personal Data anytime you are in contact with us.

QD may also combine your Personal Data with other information to provide and improve our products, services, and content (see the section below). Except as described in this Privacy Policy, QD will not give, sell, rent or loan any Personal Data to any third party.

a. Personal Data We Collect

We collect personal data you provide directly to us or which you generate when purchase the QDMINE token, use our Services or our website(s) and platform(s).

When we require certain personal data from users it is because we are required by law to collect this data (anti-fraud / anti-money laundering / counter financing of terrorism / know your customer obligations) or it is relevant for specified purposes. Any information you provide to us that is not required is voluntary.

You are free to choose whether to provide us with the types of Personal Data requested, but we may not be able to serve you as effectively or offer you all our Services when you do choose not to share certain information with us. We also collect Personal Data when you use or request information about our Services, subscribe to marketing communications, request support, complete surveys, or sign up for one of our events.

We may use this information in combination with other information we collect about you as set forth in this Privacy Policy.

b. Data Collection When Registering / Using Our Services

When opening an account to purchase the QDMINE token on DS Dashboard (3rd party application) , registering on our Site(s), or requesting support, you may be asked to provide:

- a) Contact information and personal details, such as your name, residential, business and postal addresses, telephone number, email address, and family details;
- b) Demographic details, such as date of birth, country of citizenship and/or country of residence, marital status;
- c) Information about your net worth and/or income, such as your stated net worth; stated current, historical, and expected future income; source(s) of income; and supporting documentation that you choose to submit (e.g., tax forms, tax returns,

pay stubs, financial account statements, and information about your financial assets and liabilities);

- d) Government-issued identification (to the extent permitted under applicable law), such as a national identification number (e.g., a Social Insurance Number, a Social Security Number, tax identification number, or passport number), provincial, state or local identification number (e.g., a Driver's License or other government-issued identification number), a copy of your government-issued identification card and related government issued photographs;
- e) Information about your investment experience and preferences, such as investment objectives, investment experience, liquidity needs, and risk tolerance;
- f) Financial Account and payment Information, such as your bank accounts you may use to source your investment funds, other related payment information and the cryptocurrency wallet addresses you may use to receive your QDMINE tokens and revenue payout tokens, if any;
- g) Information about your relationship to a company, such as your current occupation, job title and whether you are a beneficial owner or authorized signatory of the legal entity using the Service;
- h) Feedback and correspondence, such as information you provide when you request information from us, receive customer support, or otherwise correspond with us, including by interacting with our pages on social networking online sites or services;
- i) Marketing information, such as your preferences for receiving marketing communications and details about how you engage with our marketing communications;
- j) Transaction Information: Information about the transactions you make on our Services, such as the name of the recipient, your name, the amount, and/or timestamp.
- k) Employment Information: Office location, job title, and/or description of role.
- l) Social media information such as username or handle, preferences; and

m) Other information you choose to provide.

We may also collect Personal Data from third party partners and public sources as required or permitted by applicable law, such as public databases, credit bureaus, ID verification partners, resellers and channel partners, joint marketing partners, and social media platforms which include:

- Financial information

We may use public databases and ID verification partners to verify your identity. Our ID verification partners use a combination of government records and publicly available information about you to verify your identity. Such information includes your name, address, job position, public employment profile, credit history, status on any sanction's lists maintained by public authorities, and other relevant data. We obtain such information to comply with our legal obligations, such as anti-money laundering laws.

In some cases, we may process additional data about you to ensure our Services are not used fraudulently or for other illicit activities. In such instances, processing is necessary for us to continue to perform our contract with you and others.

c) Data Collection When Visiting Our Website

When visiting our website, we store every instance of access in a log file and therefore, the following Data are stored in this process:

- I. Computer or mobile device information
- II. Website from which our domain is accessed and website usage information
- III. Operating system of your computer
- IV. Country from which our website is accessed
- V. Name of your internet provider
- VI. Name and URL of the Data accessed
- VII. Date and time of access
- VIII. IP address of the accessing computer

Data is generally anonymized with no personal reference and only used to establish connection with the website, to ensure ongoing system security and stability and for statistical purposes. These Data are not associated or stored with Personal Data.

IP address of the accessing computers will be analyzed only in the event of an attack on the network infrastructure or in case of suspicion of otherwise unauthorized or improper use of the website and for the sole purposes of defense or use as part of criminal proceedings for identification purposes and for criminal and/or civil proceedings against the user involved. IP address is also used to filter out geographical zones from accessing our Services.

5. Limiting Use, Disclosure and Retention

Personal Information may only be used or disclosed for the purpose for which it was collected unless you have otherwise consented, or when it is required or permitted by law. Personal Information will only be retained for the period required to fulfill the purpose for which we collected it or as may be required by law.

Some of our Services, including the purchase of our QDMINE Token are subject to laws and regulations requiring us to collect and use your personal identification information, formal identification information, financial information, transaction information, employment information, online identifiers, and/or usage data in certain ways.

We must identify and verify customers using our Services to comply with anti-money laundering and terrorist financing laws across jurisdictions. In addition, we use third parties to verify your identity by comparing the personal information you provided against third-party databases and public records.

We may require you to provide additional information which we may use in collaboration with service providers acting on our behalf to verify your identity or address, and/or to manage risk as required under applicable law. If you do not want to have your personal information processed for such purposes, then we shall terminate your account as we cannot perform the Services in accordance with legal and regulatory requirements.

Collection may disclose personal data where such disclosure is necessary for compliance with a legal or to protect your vital interests or the vital interests of another natural person. Personal Information may be disclosed where such disclosure is necessary for the establishment, exercise, or defense of legal claims, whether in court proceedings or in an administrative or out-of-court procedure. An individual's Personal Information may be disclosed in response to lawful requests by public authorities, including to meet securities regulation, national security, or law enforcement requirements.

The QD website may contain links to other third-party sites that are not governed by this privacy policy. Although we endeavor to only link to sites with high privacy standards, the QD privacy policy will no longer apply once you leave the QD website. Additionally, we are not responsible for the privacy practices employed by third party websites. Therefore, we suggest that you examine the privacy statements of those sites to learn how your information may be collected, used, shared, and disclosed.

6. Accuracy

Personal Information will be maintained in as accurate, complete, and up-to-date form as is necessary to fulfill the purposes for which it is to be used.

7. Safeguarding Customer Information

Personal Information will be protected by security safeguards that are appropriate to the sensitivity level of the information. We take all reasonable precautions to protect your Personal Information from any loss or unauthorized use, access, or disclosure.

8. Disclosures Due to Legal Compliance

QD complies with all applicable privacy laws and regulations. QD may be compelled to surrender personal user or customer information to legal authorities without express user consent if presented with a court order or similar legal or administrative order, or as required or permitted by the laws, rules, and regulations of any nation, state, or other applicable jurisdiction.

Also, in the event of a violation of the Terms & Conditions of use of the Site or a violation of any restrictions on use of materials provided in or through the Site, we may disclose personal user information to our affected business partners or legal authorities.

9. Retention of Data

QD will retain your Personal Data only for as long as is necessary for the purposes set out in this Privacy Policy. QD will retain and use your Personal Data to the extent necessary to comply with our legal obligations (for example, if we are required to retain your Data to comply with applicable laws), resolve disputes, and enforce our legal agreements and policies.

Therefore, and in accordance with our record keeping obligations, we will retain Account and other Personal Data for at least five years (and some up to ten years, as required by applicable law) after an Account is closed.

10. Openness

We will make information available to you about the QD policies and practices with respect to the management of your Personal Information.

9. Links to Other Websites

QD's website may contain links to other sites that are not operated by QD. If you click on a third-party link, you will be directed to that third party's site.

QD strongly advises you to review the privacy policy of every site you visit. QD has no control over and assumes no responsibility for the content, privacy policies or practices of any third-party sites or services.

10. Customer Access

Upon request, you will be informed of the existence, use and disclosure of your Personal Information, and will be given access to it. You may verify the accuracy and completeness of your Personal Information, and may request that it be amended, if appropriate. However, in certain circumstances permitted by law, we will not disclose certain information to you. For

example, we may not disclose information relating to you if other individuals are referenced or if there are legal, security or commercial proprietary restrictions.

The QD Cookie Policy

Cookies

A cookie is a small computer file or piece of information that may be stored in your computer's hard drive when you visit the QD websites. We may use cookies to improve the QD website's functionality and in some cases, to provide visitors with a customized online experience.

Cookies are widely used and most web browsers are configured initially to accept cookies automatically. You may change your Internet browser settings to prevent your computer from accepting cookies or to notify you when you receive a cookie so that you may decline its acceptance. Please note, however, if you disable cookies, you may not experience optimal performance of the QD website.

Cookie Policy

The use of and management of Cookies is an integral part of the User experience and performance when visiting and interacting with a QD website. However, cookies may encompass information related to your Privacy as such, the Collection cookie policy is to ensure:
